College of Nurses of Ontario NP practice resources

On October 1st, 2011, amendments to the <u>Nursing Act, 1991</u> came into effect enabling NPs to broadly prescribe medications and laboratory testing. The College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO) incorporated these and other legislative changes by swiftly issuing the following documents online:
